Jayne Pearce singing "Hallelujah" on the Second Sunday of Advent.

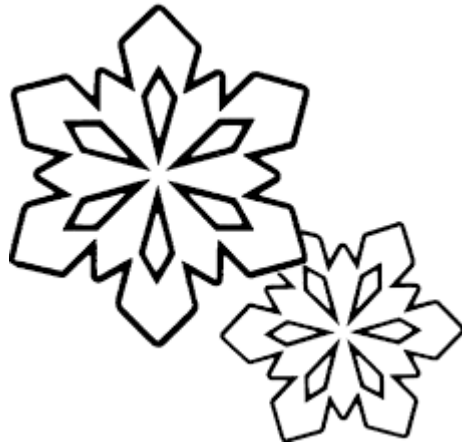
Christmas Eve Service, Meredith and Maya Garcia sang "A Wonder-Filled life".

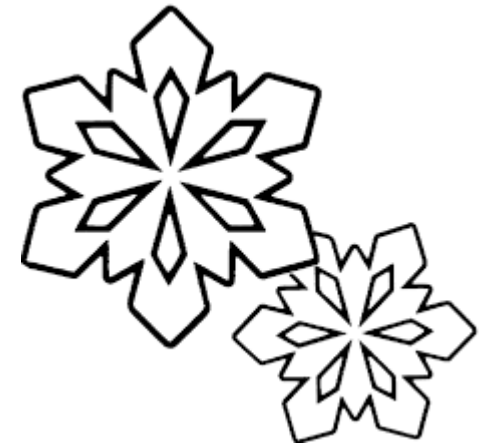
